

**Observation of Dr B Sahoo, PH Consultant during visit to different
Halls of Residence
From 6th to 30th March 2017**

Visited all the Halls of Residences to assess the hygienic condition in the halls. In most of the Halls, the kitchen and washing areas adjacent to the kitchens are found to be cleaned and hygienic condition is maintained. Bathrooms and corridors are observed to be cleaned in most of the cases. Most of the issues related to cleanliness have been informed to the Hall Manager/ Supervisors/ mess manager/ supervisors of respective halls for remedial measures. However, some of my key observations on few Halls are highlighted as below; competent authority may kindly be requested to take measures.

Some of the specific observations are highlighted as below

- Some of the Halls kitchen waste from washing areas are channelised to the rain water drain and are one of the major reasons for choking of drains. Some of the Halls clean these drains regularly. However, in some of the Halls, it requires urgent attention.
- In many Halls, kitchen products are purchased in plastic and after use the waste plastic bags are thrown here and there, even in to the drains. Such practice should be avoided.
- **Unused and old junk furniture kept in open space are required to be cleared.**
- In some of the Halls where repair work is in progress, arrangement is required for clearance of waste materials in such cases.
- **Lots of dogs and cats are there inside the campus and Hall areas which are causing public health hazards. Many students and inmates of the campus are bitten by dogs/ cats.**

**Point-wise observations on the day of visit highlighted Hall-wise
6/3/2017**

BR AMBEDKAR Hall

- Visited the Hall along with the hall manager/ supervisor.
- Grass and wild bushes cutting are required along the boundary on south and west side, back side of the hall and kitchen. Same thing was pointed out in my last visit on 4/2/17 but no action has been taken.

Zakir Hussain Hall

- Visited the Hall along with the hall staff.
- The hall of Residence is clean.

- Visited the Hall along with the hall manager/supervisor.

- The back side of kitchen should keep clean.

LLR Hall

- Visited the Hall along with the hall manager and supervisor of the hall.
- The hall is clean.

MS Hall

- Visited the Hall along with the staff of the hall.
- The hall is clean.

14/3/2017

RK Hall

- Visited the Hall along with the supervisor of the hall.
- The hall is clean.

RP Hall

- Visited the Hall along with the hall manager / supervisor.
- The hall is clean.

15/3/2017

JCB Hall

- Visited the Hall along with the hall manager / supervisor.
- The hall is clean.

HJB Hall

- Visited the Hall along with the hall manager and supervisor.
- Wild bushes and grass along the boundary line in the back side of hall and also in front of the hall.

VS Hall

- Visited the Hall along with the hall supervisor.
- The whole length of the drain, starting from kitchen to the main drain is choked with kitchen waste due to broken drain which causes blockage. Kitchen staffs are advised not to throw waste things in to drain.
